Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in special session on Friday, April 10, 2026 at 10:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge James Yates, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Dickie Clary, Keith Allen Curry, and David Ogle. Zachary Hood, Brandi Masterson and several other representatives from TDEM were also present.

Dickie Clary called the meeting to order, and a quorum was established.

FEMA (TDEM) DR4781:

The Court along with TDEM representatives discussed Hamilton County's request for advanced funding. The TDEM team advised the Court of various documentation and information needed to hopefully be approved for the advanced funding.

- **Amend the Vendor contracts to include "not to exceed a specified dollar amount"**
- **Providing the "cap" on the amended contracts will satisfy the Federal governments procurement policy by managing and monitoring vendors as to not get over charged for materials and services**
- **County is to provide documentation on how the procurement was completed**
- **Proof of public advertisements**
- **Total number of bids received**
- **Documentation of bids and acceptance of bids**
- **Debbie to provide electronic copies of the Commissioners daily logs and invoices in an excel format**



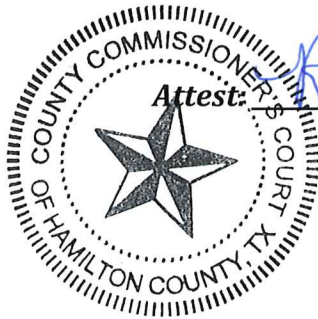
The Commissioners Court reconvened without the TDEM representatives present. Commissioner Clary asked the Court to start thinking about the financial future and the chances of actually receiving the FEMA funds in a timely manner. Commissioner Clary suggested doing an emergency budget amendment to withdraw the million dollars they had set back to gain interest during the last budget cycle. Commissioner Clary stated the monies could be withdrawn and divided between each precinct in order to move forward

with completing the needed road and bridge repairs and then reimbursed once the FEMA monies are received. More discussion on doing an emergency budget amendment will be during regular session Commissioners Court on April 28, 2026.
