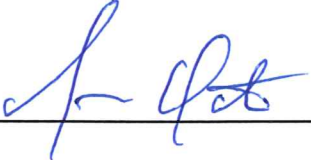

Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met on Tuesday, July 7, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. with the following members present: County Judge James Yates, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, David Ogle and Keith Curry. County Judge James Yates called the meeting to order a quorum was established. There were no pledges or invocation today.

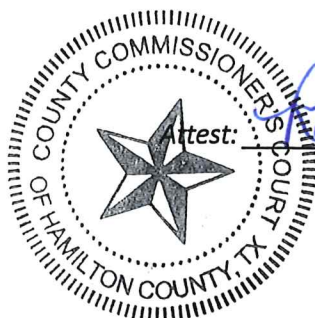
The Court discussed the following items:

- Sheriff's Department is to touch base with Tonya and Adrian to review the available funds for the SB22 grant*
- Sheriff's Department needs a new GL number created in order to separate the cell phones, land lines and hot spots*
- Sheriff's Department – multiple Accounts payable items to be reversed and paid out of the correct accounts*
- Sheriff's Department has two Crown Vick salvage cars that will bring little to no monies therefore Judge Yates asked if they would like to contact the local fire departments and donate the cars for training purposes*
- Sheriff's Department – has been charged toll fees on several occasions and they should be tolling fee exempt; the department will look into the charges*
- Sheriff's Department – will review salaries and SB22 funds towards the end of July*
- Leave the line item for K9 because the department will be reinstating the K9 program this budget cycle*
- Sheriff's Department is needing a third-party audit of the evidence room - need money budgeted in the Professional Services line*
- Communications Department - reviewed overall budget*
- Communications Department – multiple accounts payables needing to be reversed and paid out of the correct accounts*
